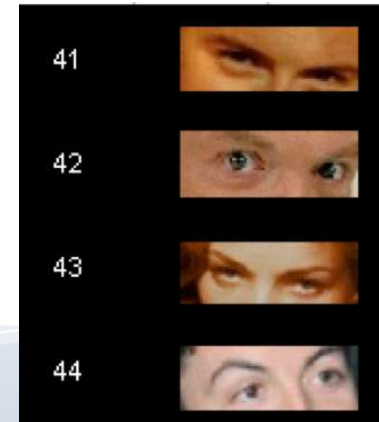
## WHY THE RED BOX CHALLENGE?

Most people love quizzes, general knowledge, trivia and competitions.

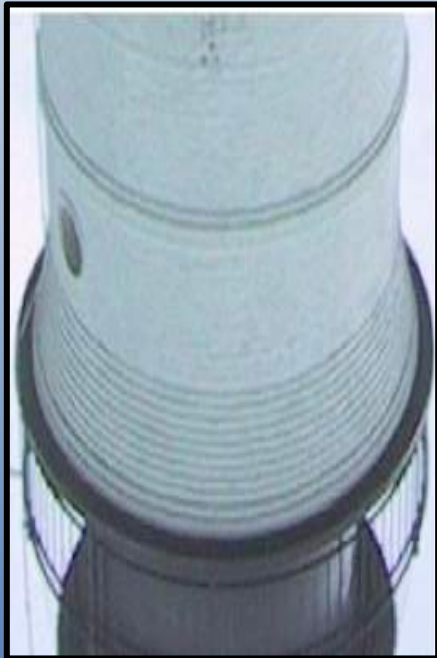
The great thing about team based, quiz style events is that there's always someone in your team who knows quite a bit about sport or food or fashion or music or whatever the topic might be.

This activity encourages team work, networking and having a great laugh whilst trying to beat the other teams.....and it's not just about answering questions either .

## HOW IT WORKS

Each table has a red box placed in the middle of it. In each box are a series of puzzles and tasks that the team as a whole must complete.

Many are questions on laminated cards and required delegates to work out / solve the answers just like a quiz.

Others require the team to make something, taste something, balance something, smell something (we have an extensive scent library!)

Group rounds include name that tune. Identifying film clips, guess contents of 'blind jars' by touch

Most importantly – the event keeps team members guessing, talking and competing.
